Share books and stories: This week we are sharing another one of our favourite stories 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen.

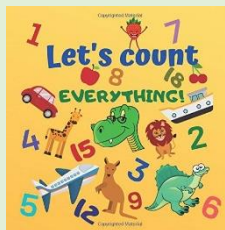
This story is great for joining in and doing the actions! You could watch the author himself telling the story [Michael Rosen sharing story](#)
