The paintbrush is 12 cm long.
The pen is 9 cm long.
The pack of pencils is 13 cm tall.
The pack of crayons is 10 cm tall.
The crayons are shorter than the pencils.
The pencils are taller than the crayons.

The scissors are longer than 12 cm because they were placed before the 0 on the ruler.

The book is shorter than 13 centimetres because it stops between 12 and 13 on the ruler.
The straight ribbon is 15 cm . The loopy ribbon is longer.
This can be proved by using string or paper strips to demonstrate.

Children measure and sort objects accurately.
The tower should be shorter than 14 cm but taller than 10 cm : $11 \mathrm{~cm}, 12 \mathrm{~cm}$ or 13 cm .
