Week 2 Phonics – ch, sh, th

Over the, week feel free to try these simple phonics lessons with your child. They should also find these sounds on their THRASS chart and have a THRASS chart to hand to help their learning.

Day One - Phonics sound 1- ch

Activity 1: Reading

Have the words: chip, chop, rich, chick

Put the words in a bag or pot and play some music. When the music stops take out a word and read it.

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (The chip is big. The chick is on the top. etc)

Day Two - Phonics sound 2- sh

Activity 1: Reading

Have the words: ship, fish, flash, shop

Put the words in a bag or pot and play some music. When the music stops take out a word and read it.

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (The fish is gold. The shop is shut etc)

Day Three - Phonics sound 3- ng

Activity 1: Reading

Have the words: bang, sing, song, king

Put the words in a bag or pot and play some music. When the music stops take out a word.

Activity 2: Writing

Have a go at writing the words with your child.

Show them how to write it in a sentence or encourage them to do this independently. (The king sang a song. The man is banging etc)
