

Activity: Choose a page from a book that you have enjoyed reading over lockdown. Then, see if you can fill in as many words from that page and put them into the right part of the grid. Don't worry if you cannot do all of the words on the page – **just do the ones that you can**. If you are reading a book that doesn't have many words on each page, you might want to choose 2 pages for this activity.

First, let's recap what each of these words mean:

- Adjective – A describing word (green, small, furious)
- Noun – A person, place or thing
- Verb – a doing word or action (leap, stomp, crawl) – Don't forget to look out for 'ing' or 'ed' suffixes.
- Challenge: Adverbials - Adverbials are words that we use to give more information about a verb. They can be one word (*angrily, here*) or phrases (*at home, in a few hours*) and often say how, where, when or how often something happens or is done
