

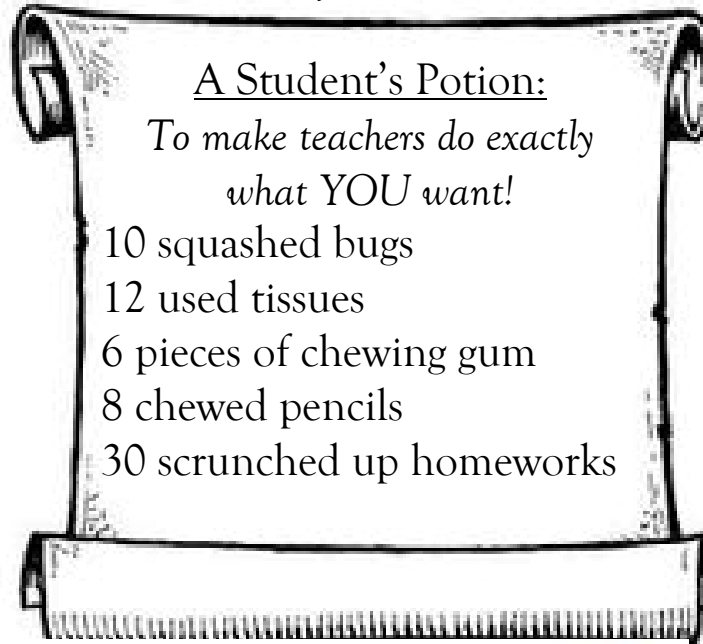

Adapt the potion for 1 teacher.

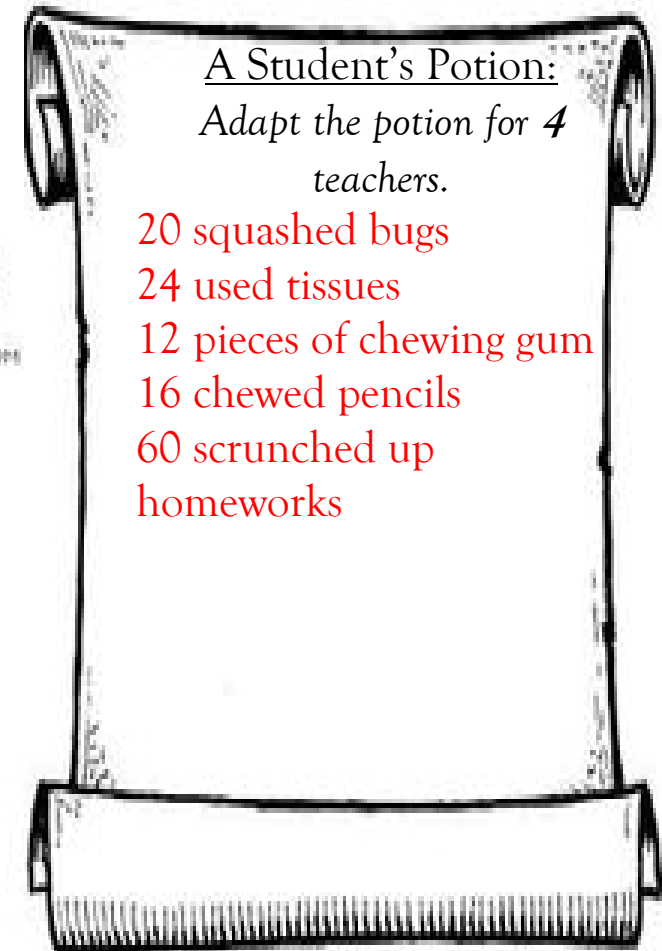
5 squashed bugs
