# Ratio

- What is a ratio?
- A ratio compares parts of one thing to parts of something else

# Ratio

- What is the ratio of women to men who work in the Police force? There are 96,000 men and 32,000 women.
- What is the ratio of cement to sand needed to make mortar? The builder uses 1.7kg of sand and 850g of cement to make a batch of mortar.

# Simplifying Ratios

- We simplify ratios in the same way we simplify fractions:
  - look for the HCF of all the parts
  - Divide all parts by the HCF
- Example: Simplify  $28 : 40$                        $12 : 20 : 36$

# Dividing in a given ratio

- Divide 20m in the ratio 3 : 1
  1. Find the total number of parts  $3 + 1 = 4$
  2. Find the size of each part  $20 \div 4 = 5$
  3. Multiply to find each share  $3 \times 5 = 15$   
 $1 \times 5 = 5$
  4. Write your answer as a ratio, in the same order, using units if appropriate.  $15\text{m} : 5\text{m}$

# Dividing in a given ratio

- Divide £60 in the ratio 2 : 3 : 7
  1. Find the total number of parts  $2 + 3 + 7 = 12$
  2. Divide the amount by this number  $60 \div 12 = 5$   
 $2 \times 5 = 10$
  3. Multiply to find each share  $3 \times 5 = 15$   
 $7 \times 5 = 35$
  4. Write your answer as a ratio, in the same order, using units if appropriate.  $\pounds 10 : \pounds 15 : \pounds 35$

- It's found that on average, the number of consonants to vowels on a page is in the ratio 5 : 2.
- If there are 120 vowels on a page, how many consonants would you expect there to be?
