The Lady with the lamp	Wounded soldiers in the Crimean War named Florence this because she carried a lamp with her whilst at work caring for the patients in the hospital.
Scutari hospital	A British military hospital for soldiers, located in Turkey.
military	The group or groups of people that are given power to defend something (usually a country) from its enemies. They are usually armed with weapons.
nurse	A person trained to care for sick and unwell people and to make sure the place of care (eg. hospital) is kept clean so that germs are not spread.
significant person	An important person who made a change in the past which has influenced the way our lives are today.
Crimean War (1853 – 1856)	It broke out during the Victorian times. It was a conflict where Russia lost to an empire made up of France, United Kingdom and Sardinia.
sanitation	Having ways to get rid of human waste (poo and wee) safely. It also includes ways to keep things clean by throwing away rubbish. It is important because it helps to stop the spread of germs and diseases.
wounded	An injury to the body.
