

Spring nests Literacy task

Look at the method below for making Spring nests. Can you find all the imperative (also known as bossy) verbs? Remember there might be more than one in some sentences.

Method:

1. Wash your hands.
2. Put your apron on.
3. Break the chocolate into pieces and put in your bowl.
4. Place the bowl over a pan of simmering hot water and stir gently with a wooden spoon.
5. When the chocolate is melted remove from the heat and stir in your favourite cereal. Add enough so that all the cereal is in coated in chocolate. It's best to do this a bit at a time.
6. Put the paper cases in a muffin tin or if you don't have one lay them out on a baking tray.
7. Carefully spoon the mixture into the cases making sure there is the same amount in each one. It should make 10 muffin sized nests or 12 cupcake sized nests.
8. Using a rolling pin push the end into the centre of each nest to make the nest shape.
9. Place in the fridge to set for approximately 15 to 20 minutes.
10. Finally, decorate each nest with the small sugar-coated eggs and chicks and enjoy!
