

Heymann Easter Egg Challenge!

Here are your challenge activities for Easter.

Colour the egg in when you have managed to complete the activity.

Can you collect all 6 eggs?

Make an egg and soldiers

A grown up can soft boil an egg- can you carefully cut the soldiers to dunk?



Make some nest cakes

Melt some chocolate- talk about how the chocolate changes.

Mix in some Rice Krispies/Shredded Wheat or Cornflakes and add to paper cake cases. Can you count 3 eggs to go on top?



Let's get squiggling!

Draw a lamb with Squiglet on YouTube 'Get Squiggling Lamb S1E9'

(You could do this in your home learning books)



Bird feeder

Using an old milk bottle- get a grown up to carefully cut out an opening. You can then decorate using marker pens/tissue paper and hang outside with bird seeds/bread in.



Springtime baby animals

Can your grown ups help you learn the names of some baby animals (e.g. chicken- chick
sheep- lamb
cow- calf
horse- foal



Signs of Spring

Talk to a grown up about the signs of Spring (flowers budding, birds, nesting blossom on trees etc.)

Can you spot any through the window or on your daily walk?
