Our Nursery Places



Our nursery has 39 places based on 2 sessions per day. Places are available in the year before your child starts Reception class. We offer flexibility of Care using the free 15 hours funding, 30-hour Extended funding if eligible, and/or various tax-free schemes. Morning sessions run from 8:30am until 11:30am and afternoon sessions from 12:15pm until 3:15pm.We offer full wraparound care, enabling your child to stay all day from 7.30am to 6.00pm if required.

A limited number of places may be offered to younger children who are over the age of 3 subject to availability.













Wrap-Around Care
