We are learning new graphemes, often 2 letters (digraphs) or 3 letters (trigraphs) that together make a sound we already know. See if you can spot them in words around the house. The 4 this week ay, ea, ou, and oy come at different points within words- can you help your child notice the pattern?

ay is at the end of a word where as /ai/ is in the middle.

Oy is also at the end of a word. Remember oi is in the middle making the same sound.

/ou/ and /ea/ are usually in the middle, occasionally at the start.
