




**Davies, Nicola**

Explores the evolution of plants on the Earth and how they have contributed to the wonderful world of nature that we enjoy. Informative and interesting with lots of detail in the illustrations.



Join our intrepid explores in Jurassic times where they discover the marvellous dinosaurs that lived long ago. Very bright illustrations and rhyming text.



Lyrical text explores the unique challenges, joys and experiences of becoming a blended family.


