Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) are designed to support the development of the mental skills that underpin much of the maths work in school. Instant recall facts help enormously with mental agility within maths lessons.

Your child's KIRF this term is to know all doubles to 20 e.g 1+1 =2, 5+ 5 = 10, 6 + 6= 12, 9 + 9 = 18	
Counting forwards and back within 50	50, 49, 48, 47 3, 2, 1
Recognise ½ of an object, shape or quantity	
Recognise ¼ of an object, shape or quantity	quarter of 4 equal parts.
Count in tens to 100.	10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100
Count in twos	2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20
Count in fives	5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50
To recognise coins and know their value	1p 2p 5p 10p 20p 50p £1 £2 1penny 2pence 5 pence 10 pence 20 pence 50 pence 1 pound 2 pounds
Count in 5s including 5ps and £5s	5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30 5p 10p 15p
