Maths

In Autumn 2 we will be learning about addition and subtraction within 10, using part, part, whole models, practical objects and number lines. We will also be learning about measuring length, introducing rulers!

English

In English, we are looking at the story of 'The magic porridge pot' to create stories with exciting and descriptive settings. We will be using our Talk for writing process to write our own magic stories. We will then be learning about Instructions to make our own 'magic porridge'.

Phonics

We will be having daily 'Little Wandle' phonics lessons where we continue to learn some alternative vowel digraph and trigraph spellings. We will be reading in groups too.

Year One-Autumn 2

Curriculum Drivers:

Creative Thinking - Children will be encouraged to solve problems creatively and collaboratively with their peers. They will apply their learning in making moving pictures and Pic Collages.

Diversity - Children will learn about the different festivitals people celebrate at this time of year and how schools have changed.

Emotional Intelligence - Children will learn how to communicate their thoughts, feelings and opinions as well as listen to others.

Community - Children's learning will be enhanced by our Stay and Play sessions where parents and carers can share what toys they played with when they were children.

Science

We will continue to explore the properties of materials and what each material is used for. We will learn words such as bendy, absorbent, water proof, opaque and transparent.

We will also be observing how the seasons are changing.

PSHE

At Heymann, we use the 'Jigsaw' scheme of work to teach our, PSHE lessons. In Autumn 2, we will be looking at the theme of 'Celebrating difference' which will link to the idea of us being unique.

History

We will be looking at how Toys have changed since our parents and Grandparents were children. We are inviting our parents/carers into school to share their toys as well as visiting Sudbury museum of childhood to discover more about toys in the past

DT

We will be investigating how to make moving pictures using levers and sliders. We will practise skills and then design our own moving picture before evaluating it.

Music

We will be finding out about the colonel Hathi's march (from the Jungle book). We will explore moving and counting in time to march music, composing their own marching music, listening to contrasting low and high instruments typically found in a marching band, as well as responding to music through movement.

ICT

We will use 'PicCollage' on the iPad to create posters about our favourite toys
