
Why are the caves an important part of Nottingham's history?


The city of Nottingham has hundreds of man-made caves, which have been in use for over a thousand years. The caves are not natural and have been made using simple tools because of the soft sandstone.


893 AD	Nottingham caves were discovered
1500 AD	Caves used as a tannery
1941	86 public air raid shelter were found beneath the city in the sandstone, holes were also dug here to supply sand for sandbags used during WW2.
Current Day	Caves are used as a tourist attraction
