This is the 7<sup>th</sup> year of this SOW at Heymann. Previously, French was the sole MFL taught at the school, but a decision was made in 2020 to introduce Spanish to the school curriculum (see separate document with letter to governors for reasons why). Spanish was introduced in Y2 and Y3 in September 2020 and will progress through the school with these year groups. It was considered correct to allow the more senior year groups to continue with French to allow a higher level of attainment for these pupils. Therefore year 5/6 pupils will study French in 2021/22.

There are 3 classes in each year group and each class will study MFL for a 4 week block in each term.

There is some overlap of topics between year groups where Spanish is taught which will shift as each year group comes on board. Therefore, new and additional topics will be introduced in subsequent years.
