

Year One– Spring term

Maths

This term we will be learning about numbers up to 50– understanding what each digit means and how to use a number line. Our addition and subtraction skills will extend to number within 20. We will also be learning about measuring mass and volume.



English

In English, we are starting with Information texts about animals.

We will be writing our own description stories based on Paddington in London.

We will be learning about persuasive writing, encouraging people to visit London!

Phonics

We will be having daily 'Little wandle' phonics lessons. We will be reading in groups too.

PE

We will be learning some drumming and sending and receiving in our PE sessions. Please come in PE kits on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Curriculum Drivers:

Creative Thinking - Children will be encouraged to solve problems creatively and collaboratively with their peers.

Diversity - Children will learn about the different parts of the UK and particularly London. They learn about a range of festivals and how they are celebrated.

Emotional Intelligence - Children will learn how to communicate their thoughts, feelings and opinions as well as listen to others.

Community - Children's learning will be enhanced visiting the local fire station and visitors to support with our sewing project.

Science

We will be learning about animals, classifying them (mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds and fish) and how animals are similar and different. We will also spot seasonal changes.



Music

We will be using Sing up to learn about pitch, tempo and timbre listening to 'Dawn' from *Sea interludes* by Benjamin Britten.



PSHE

At Heymann, we use the 'Jigsaw' scheme of work to teach our, PSHE lessons. This term we will look at Dreams and goals and Healthy me.

Geography

Children will be learning the four countries that make up the UK and the surrounding seas. We will focus on what is unique about London.

History

Children will learn what happened in the Great Fire of London and compare how London is different now to how it was in 1666.



DT

We will be investigating how puppets are made and sewing hand puppets.

ICT

We will use 'Animatic' on the ipads to create our own stop frame animations. We will also make music on Chrome music lab.

RE

In our Assemblies and circle times we will continue to think about festivals celebrated. We will be learning about how the Jewish faith explain 'Creation to Shabbat'.
