Maths

This term we will be learning about numbers up to 100. We are introduced to multiplication (counting in 2's, 5's and 10's) and fractions (finding halves and quarters of shapes and amounts). We will also be looking at money and learning to tell the time to the o'clock and half past.

English

In English, we will be describing characters using a version of Handa's Surprise. We will be retelling the Magic Porridge pot story and writing a recount. We will also have our invention week in May where we write alongside the rest of the school.

Phonics

We will be having daily 'Little wandle' phonics lessons. We will be reading in groups too. After half term we will be completing our phonics screening check— see bulletin for information.

PF

We will be learning target, invasion and striking and fielding games. We will also learn yoga. Please come in PE kits on Monday and Wednesdays.

Year One-Summer term

Curriculum Drivers:
